This competition will run under the new competition framework using the Personal Ranking Index (PRI) system **Prizes** are awarded in each class with 2 or more entries and 2 or more starting. Competitors may be moved to a higher category, dependent upon entries. Please indicate if you are NOT willing to be moved. Banding for Senior events will be announced when the draw is completed. Masters and Junior events will remain unchanged from last year. Masters handicaps may be used (see Local Rules). Prizes will be presented at the Yare Boat Club following the end of racing. Light refreshments will be on sale at the Yare BC following the afternoon division.

- Entry Fee: £10 per seat in advance (excluding cox) or £12 on the day; entries and payment via BROE2 only. Entries close at 6pm Monday 17<sup>TH</sup> September. The draw will be made at Yare Boat Club at 10am on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> September. The start order will be based on last year's finishing times, with new entries following in alphabetical order, in each category and will be published electronically on Tuesday evening.
